## JOSEPH RAY MEMORIAL SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Each November members will receive a form to tally their service points for involvement in committees/chairs within the organization. Points begin at zero on January 1st of each year then accumulate throughout the year. Each January the Executive board awards the member with the highest point value a scholarship (value \$350 to a PPW, SPPA, PPA, WPPI, Photoshop, marketing, or continued education event).

As an active PCPPA member, you contribute to the association. To ensure it doesn't go unrecognized, you may be eligible to win our \$350 Joseph Ray Memorial Service Scholarship. Service is a valuable attribute and deserves to be recognized.
